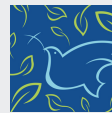

Through sermons, daily devotions, small group sharing, and fellowship, we hope to grow together in God's Word, encourage one another, and continue to mature in our faith.



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The theme of our previous camp was "After God's Own Heart," reminding us not to live according to our own desires, but to seek what pleases the Lord. This year's theme, "To Live Is Christ," continues this calling. To live for Christ is not only about serving in church, but about putting Christ first in our families, workplaces, relationships, and every decision we make — offering our time, gifts, and lives for His purposes. 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This year, we are pleased to have Pastor Edward Shyu as our main speaker. YAYF MINISTRY



In the Young Adults and Youth Fellowship (YAYF) ministry, we often ask these questions: When a youth joins this ministry at the age of 13, how can we best help him or her navigate the challenges of life and church? How can we disciple this youth to know God more deeply and live out the gospel faithfully? How can we encourage him or her to be committed to building up the body of Christ - the church?

With these questions in mind, we seek to shepherd our youths and young adults through both Bible Study classes and Fellowship programmes. Bible Study classes are held on Sundays from 10:00am to 12:00pm, while Fellowship programmes are held on Saturdays from 2:30pm to 4:30pm from July onwards. Both Bible Study and Fellowship aim to teach biblical and theological truths so that students may know God and love Him more. However, they do so with different approaches and emphases. Bible Study focuses on learning biblical theology and applying it to life together with peers of the same or similar age. Fellowship, on the other hand, explores biblical truths and relevant life topics with a greater emphasis on living out the Christian life in community across a wider age range.

Year 3 Bible Study (Youths)



For Bible Study, youths aged 13 to 16 spend their first four years going through a brief survey of the Old Testament and New Testament. This helps them gain a clearer understanding of God, the Bible, and the storyline of Scripture. From ages 17 to 19, the young adults then delve deeper into important topics such as: What are the biblical covenants, and how are they relevant today? Who is Jesus, and what does it mean to believe in Him? What is the church, and what is its purpose? What are spiritual gifts, and how should I use them to serve? From July onwards, young adults aged 20 and above will also have a new series called “YA Table Talk”, which aims to equip them in various areas of life and faith through formats that are more relaxed, interactive, and conversational.

For Fellowship, biblical truths are taught either through particular books of the Bible or through topics related to the Christian life. A typical session includes teaching, small group discussions, application, and prayer sharing within the group. Recently, during a youth fellowship session, we taught the theme of unity from John 15. In the second half of the session, the youths made hand soap in the shape of grapevines, helping them reflect creatively on what it means to abide in Christ and remain united as His people.

Fellowship also provides opportunities for bonding, which is an important part of Christian community. This takes place through games, outings, camps, retreats, and informal gatherings. A few times a year, we also hold evangelistic events where our youths and young adults invite friends and family to hear the gospel.

Through YAYF ministry, our hope is not just to run programmes, but to shepherd the next generation to know Christ, love His Word, serve His church, and live faithfully in the world. We are thankful for the teachers, leaders, and brothers and sisters who labour together in this ministry. Please continue to pray that our youths and young adults will grow in maturity, be rooted in the gospel, and become faithful members of Christ's body for His glory.
