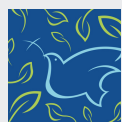


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EDEN'S 27TH ANNIVERSARY SPECIAL EDITION

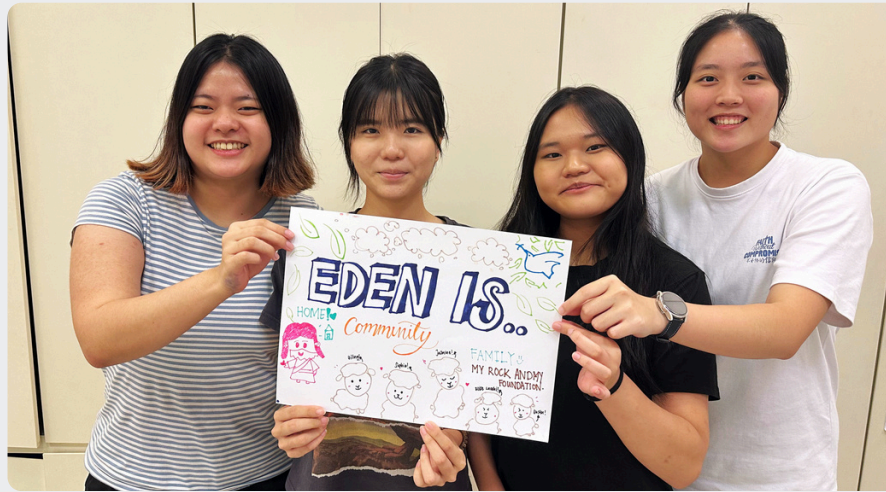

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WHAT DOES EDEN MEAN TO YOU?



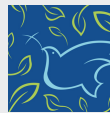
